- We maintain an extensive recycling program for paper, packaging, products, and chemicals



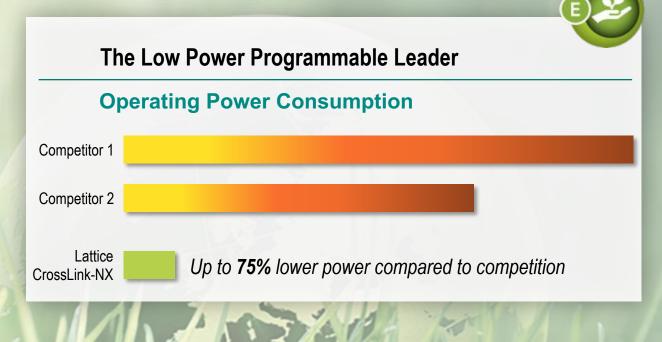

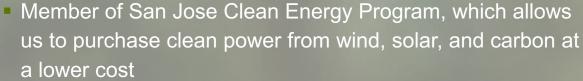


CONSERVATION

With innovative process technology & circuit design, Lattice has delivered multiple generations of Clean Tech products that reduce our customer's power consumption and extend their product lives.



As a fabless semiconductor company, the sustainable operation of our office buildings globally accounts for the majority of our environmental impact; therefore, Lattice reviews the latest technologies and regulatory trends to support consistent energy reduction for improved results.



- Increased our offices' sustainability by converting 25% of our sites to LED lighting and sensors and expanding the program to additional locations
- Optimized building performance by upgrading HVAC equipment
- Upgraded 18 EV charging stations to rapid-charging stations to support increasing EV demand





Water Quality and Conservation

Our facilities generally minimize water use, and we remain committed to reducing our water usage.

- Bathrooms remodeled with hands-free flush valves and faucets
- Converted oven rooms to chilled water system saving over 30,000 gallons of water per day

As a fabless semiconductor company, Lattice utilizes a subcontracted supply chain

We work exclusively with industry-leading suppliers. Our primary silicon foundry partners include: UMC, TSMC, and Samsung. Each of these silicon suppliers are leaders in the semiconductor industry as well as leaders in corporate responsibility.

Our primary OSAT (Assembly & Test) partner is <u>Advanced</u> <u>Semiconductor Engineering (ASE)</u> with an industry leading ESG program.



Supply Chain Management – Driving Consistent Compliance

Ensuring Compliance Global Standards/Certifications

- Lattice requires all our supply chain partners to maintain <u>ISO14001 registrations</u> which certifies a company's commitment to preserving the natural environment
- We have followed industry-best practices that removed Lead
 (Pb) from solder compositions and converted plastic
 packages to Halogen-free formulations
- We have worked with our OSATs to eliminate the use of Conflict Minerals from our products. We regularly publish a CMRT (Conflict Mineral Reporting Template) that documents all the mineral smelters used in our supply chain
- We adhere to the European chemical standards of <u>REACH</u> and <u>RoHS</u>

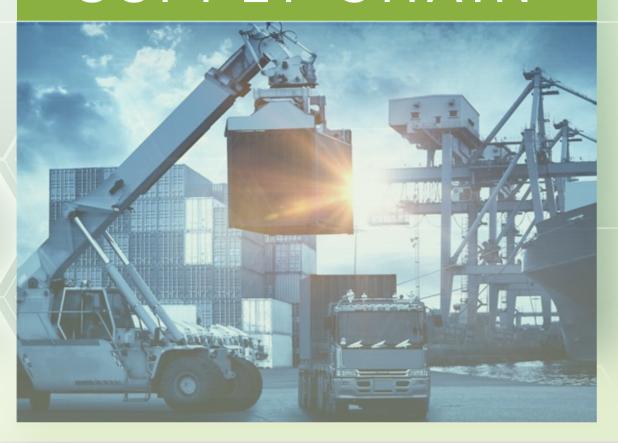

Supply Chain Management – Driving Consistent Compliance (cont.)

Additional Activities to Ensure Compliance

- Lattice requires our primary supply chain partners to also acknowledge and implement the principles within the RBA Code of Conduct: <u>UMC</u>, <u>TSMC</u>, <u>Samsung</u>, and <u>ASE</u>. This code of conduct spells out the minimum requirements for worker's rights, occupational safety, environmental impact and business ethics
- We work with our OSAT's to reclaim minerals from ICs that are rejected during the manufacturing process
- We perform Quarterly Business Reviews of our OSATs and annual audits of our Foundry suppliers

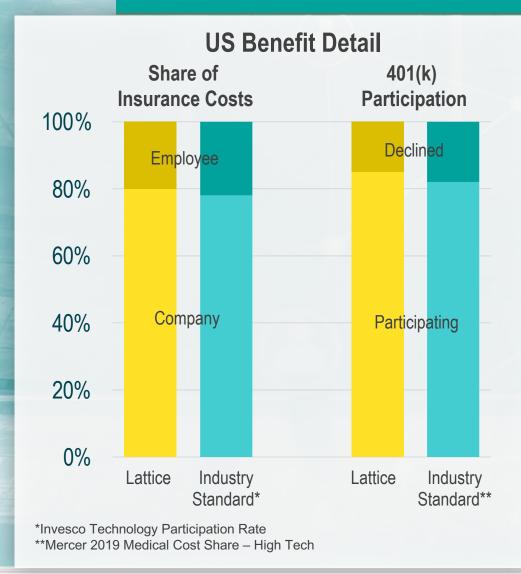

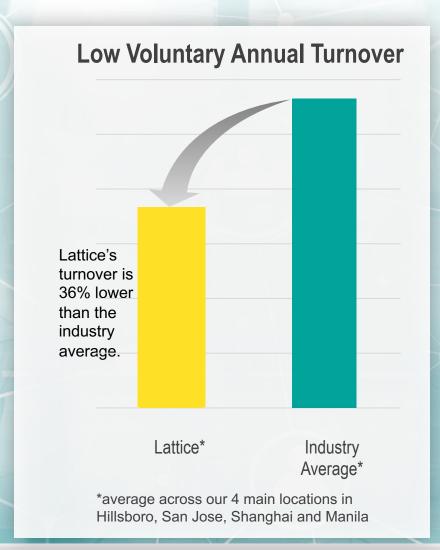
